
Operation & Parts List


For use only with regular face or cored brick. (Will not cut hard fired brick pavers)

- 1. Assemble components according to parts list on the back.
- 2. Turn the height adjustment handle (item #16) until the top knife is approximately 1/4" above the material to be split.
- 3. Hold handle (item *2) in a two o'clock position and turn height adjustment handle (item *16) counter-clock wise until the top knife rests firmly on the material. The splitter is now adjusted properly. Whenever the material fractures first at the bottom, continue the downward stroke of the handle until the material is split. If the split does not occur at the extreme of the downward stroke, raise the handle and adjust the top knife downward slightly.
- **4.** For rock-facing the ends of brick or etc., adjust the splitter in the same manner as previously explained. Allow approximately 3/8" to 1/4" of the end of the unit to be rock-faced to protrude past the knife. The amount to be taken off to give a rock-face appearance depends upon the height and density of the material.

For 45 degree splitting across the bed of materials, refer to the following instructions.




a. Place the unit to be mitered with the face against the up-right post and positioned with the desired line to cut directly with the knives. (Illustration *1)




b. Any protrusion on the heal of the split that might interfere with a uniform fit may be trimmed away (Illustration *2)


Mitering unit for window ledges:



a. Hold the unit with the face toward the post and at the desired angle. (Illustration *3)



CAUTION: Be safe, always wear safety goggles!




A handy portable splitter that can shave every brick to fit!

Assembly Instructions

1. Attach wood base (Item *10) to base assembly (Item *11) with (4) 2-1/4" carriage bolts

Wood Base

- (4) 3/8" flat washers
- (4) 5/16" hex nuts
- 2. Attach cutting table (Item #4) to base assembly
 - with (3) 1-1/2" machine screws
 - (3) rubber cushions
 - (3) 1/4" flat washers
 - (3) 1/4" hex nuts

Remember:

Keep all moving parts free of dirt and lubricated with a thin film of oil.

Always keep cutting table adjusted approximately level with cutting edge of bottom knife.



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
